



Precautions for the New Year Holiday

The University of Tokyo takes very seriously (disciplinary action) any accidents involving alcohol.

Students are asked to take careful note of the following precautions before engaging in alcohol consumption.

[Precautions when consuming alcohol]

- 1) Underage drinking is prohibited.
- 2) Excessive drinking, and dangerous behaviour e.g. downing alcohol (chug-a-lug drinking, in Japanese, *ikki-nomi*) are prohibited.
- 3) It is forbidden to force others to drink alcohol (Alcohol Harassment).
- 4)Drink-driving is a serious criminal act and is prohibited. (※ It is also strictly forbidden to offer alcohol to those who are planning on driving or cycling.)

In addition to alcohol-related incidents, the University of Tokyo will also take disciplinary action against any other inappropriate behaviour (accident or breach of rules) by its students. Even during the break, please always bear in mind that you are a student of the University of Tokyo, and act responsibly.

In the unlikely event of an accident or an incident, please report promptly to the emergency contacts below.
