## Change in Alert Stage on Komaba I Campus

Thank you all for your continued cooperation with the countermeasures against COVID infections.

The government has decided to end the priority measures that took effect on January 21, 2022, to prevent the spread of infections. Those measures ended nationwide, including in Tokyo, as of Monday, March 21.

In response, and based on an overall assessment of the infection situation both on and off campus and in accordance with "The University of Tokyo Activity Restrictions Index for Preventing the Spread of Coronavirus Disease 2022," the university has decided to relax the university-wide activity restriction level from Level B to Level A as of today, Monday, March 28.

Based on this change, we are changing the alert stage for the Komaba I Campus from Stage Orange I to Stage Yellow effective today. Because these alert stages were devised at the beginning of the pandemic and because the infection situation has evolved since then as the virus itself has mutated, we plan to revise the guidelines for our alert stages. The revised stages will take effect on the Komaba I campus as of Friday, April 1.

We appreciate your understanding of these changes and ask that you continue to take countermeasures against the spread of COVID infections.
