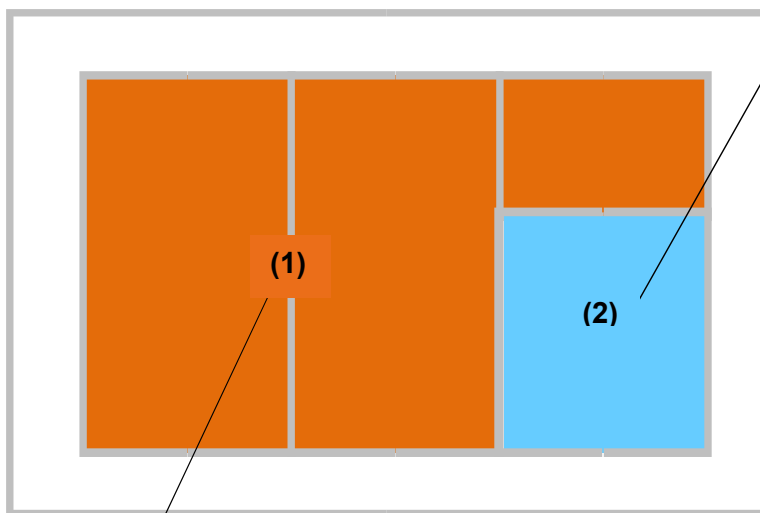

How to read the Grade Report for 1S1 Term

(1) Grades for Each Courses

Grades obtained in 1S1 Term will be shown as "18.04~18.06" in "Course Term" column. For NSII students in the first year, the credits and the grade points required to pass Mathematical Sciences courses by the overall point average at the end of 1S Semester are shown in the "Credits" and the "Grade" column using the minus sign on the right side of the "Course" column. When you complete Mathematical Sciences courses at the end of 1S Semester, the passing credits and grade points will take the place of the deficiency.

(2) Credits Gained/ Percentage Point Averages

The credits passed and used for calculating "Basic Point Average" are shown in the "Credits Gained" section. Credits for Thematic Courses are not included here as the courses are evaluated on a Pass/Fail basis.

The "Basic Point Average" indicated in "Percentage Point Averages" section is a weighted average and based on the credits and grade points received from all courses taken except for Thematic Courses. For details, see the following pages on "Introduction of Basic Point Average".
