Announcement

- ◆ If you are unable to attend in person classes for all courses throughout the 2022A Semester, you may request the "Online Learning Request" around late August to early September.
- Application for each course will NOT be accepted. If you apply for online learning, you must take all PEAK courses to be offered in the 2022A Semester online.
- Application on the grounds of infection anxiety will not be accepted.
- This application only applies to the Junior Division PEAK courses.
- Courses for the April-entry students will be conducted face-to-face in principle except for the first week. Moreover, some face-to-face courses may not be taken online due to the course method or the

conditions of the instructor. It is NOT permitted to request for April-entry students' courses to be offered online for being abroad.

- Online learning students must refrain from any nonessential and non-urgent outings during the online learning period to prevent infection.
- Online learning students are NOT allowed to participate in club activities (except for those that can be participated in at home via online) during the online learning period to prevent infection.
- Online learning students are NOT allowed to work part-time outside the home with opportunities to interact with others during the online learning period to prevent infection.
