### Changes in “PEAK Academic Handbook”

### III. Course Registration Procedures and Grade Evaluation

(5) Grade Evaluation (page 58, “PEAK Academic Handbook (October 2014) ” )

① Grades for Foundation Courses and Integrated Courses are evaluated according to the table below. Academic performance is assigned one of ~~four~~ five grades: A+, A, B, C, or F/Fail. (Omitted)

**It is generally accepted that grading is balanced so that one-third of the students receive the grade of “A+” and “A”.**

Thematic Courses are not assigned points, and are instead evaluated on a pass/fail basis.
