How to read the Grade Report for 2S Semester & 2S1,2S2 Term

(1) Required Credits /Credits Gained/ Further Credits Required

"Required Credits" : Course and credit requirements for completion of the Junior Division, and advancing to the Senior Division. (Please refer to PEAK Academic Handbook P.18.)

% If you do not fulfill the requirements for advancing to the Senior Division at the end of the 2S semester, you will be automatically required to repeat year.

"Credits Gained": The credits you have gained by the end of 2S Semester.

%The credits for courses passed by the overall point average are included.

"Further Credits Required" : The credits required to gain for advancing to the Senior Division. These are shown only when you do not have enough credits for the requirements.

(2) Simple Average for Each Course Group

Simple Average and the number of credits for courses (whose grade points have been) used in the calculation of Simple Average will be recorded on the Grade Report. The courses used in the calculation of Simple Average are as follows:

Foundation Courses: • All Foreign Languages, Information, Physical Education and Health Sciences, First-Year Seminar

• Social Sciences and Humanities for which you gained credits

Intermediate Courses: All Courses for which you gained credits

Integrated Courses: All courses for which you gained credits

[NS students]

- Foundation Courses: All Foreign Languages, Information, Physical Education and Health Sciences, First-Year Seminar, Mathematical Sciences, Material and Life Sciences
 - · Social Sciences and Humanities for which you gained credits

Intermediate Courses: All Courses for which you gained credits

Integrated Courses: All courses for which you gained credits

*Please note that the credits which appear under "Credits Gained" section are the credits that are used for Simple Average calculation. The credits for Thematic Courses are not included in "Credits Gained" section of Simple average as these courses evaluate as pass or fail.



(3) Courses that Determine Pass/Fail by Overall Point Average

Check your overall point average and Pass/Fail from the "Credits Gained" section for each course category, or grades for each course category on the left side of the Grade Report. For further information, refer to p.62 of the PEAK Academic Handbook.

(4) "Course Term" on the Grade Report

"Course Term" shown on the Grade Report indicates the term when the course finished. Courses for S1 term will be " $17.04 \sim 17.04$ ", courses for S2 term will be " $17.04 \sim 17.08$ ", and courses for

S Semester will be shown as "17.04 \sim 17.07" on the grade report.
