## Registering for "English I (PEAK)" in 2025A

To register for "English I (PEAK)", an optional course for PEAK students, it is required to take special procedures as follows. <u>Students cannot register for the course through UTAS.</u> Please note that if you intend to obtain qualification for the conferring of Educational Personnel Certification, the credits must be earned.

From the list of courses (to be available from around October 2) at the bottom of this notice, first attend the first class (Online) you wish to take, inform the instructor that you are a PEAK student and wish to take "English I (PEAK)", and obtain permission from the instructor. Please note that this course will be offered jointly with a part of the "English language (Advanced)" course for April-entry students.

If the number of applicants exceeds the class capacity, a lottery will be held in the first class. If you cannot obtain permission for the class you wish to register for, please obtain permission from the course instructor for another course you wish to register for by e-mail, or UTOL, before or after the class, etc. Once you have received permission from the course instructor, please submit <a href="this form">this form</a> (\*accessible through Oct.2- Oct.22) by 4:50PM, October 22.

Students may take <u>no more than one course</u>. (\*If you have already earned credits for "English I (PEAK)", you cannot take a new course.)

The credits earned can be included in the "Credits Required Other Than the Credits Required for Foundation Courses, Intermediate Courses, Integrated Courses, and Thematic Courses".

You cannot register for "English 1 (PEAK)" which is not in the list below. **Even if you have permission from the instructor, the course will not be registered.** 

When a class reaches its maximum number of class capacity, the application will be closed at that time. Please check the list below frequently as it is subject to updating.
