### 1. Issue of Warning Tickets

On Tuesday, 11 December warning tickets (yellow) were put on bicycles which were unregistered with the University and left without permission on campus.

#### 2. Notice Period

The above-mentioned warning tickets carry a 2-week grace period (until 24 December), during which the owners of the bicycles are required to remove the warning tickets in order to confirm their ownership. Owners are urged to register their bicycles with the University as soon as possible.

### 3. Retention Period

Bicycles still with warning tickets after 2 weeks will be deemed ownerless and classified for disposal, and will be kept for approximately 1 month (until 24<sup>th</sup> January).

Once the retention period is over, bicycles classified for disposal will undergo the relevant administrative procedure and will be disposed of all together by the University.
