#### 3. The checkup includes:

Medical history, blood pressure and pulse, blood tests, height and body weight, chest X-ray (you will be permitted to skip this examination, if you are pregnant or think you may be pregnant.), urinalysis, electrocardiography, Mental Health Questionnaire.

#### 4. Preparations:

Please bring your student ID card with you, and make sure to wear plain-colored T-shirts (see note 5-2) below)

#### 5. Please note the following points on the Health Check-up :

 If you wish to take your medical check-up on Hongo Campus, please make a reservation through the website. For details on making the reservation, please access http://www.hc.u-tokyo.ac.jp/ .

- 2) As chest X-rays will be taken, please wear light clothing. Women are requested to wear thin, plaincolored T-shirt without buttons or metal fittings, and please do not wear "bra-top" type clothing. Please bring something to tie your hair if you wear it long. Also, please make sure you are able to bare your ankles for the electrocardiography – therefore please refrain from wearing tights or stockings.
- 3) All students are required to have a health check-up. Without medical check-up documentations, you will not be able to obtain certificates required for enrolling in specialty courses, moving to another university and for making various applications. If you miss the health check-up on this occasion, the next available check-up is not until next April to June.
- 4) Please call the relevant Health Service Center if you are unable to attend the check-up on the date for justifiable reasons, such as hospitalization and so on.
- 5) Health certificates will be issued after about three weeks from the date of the examination.
- 6) Please inform the relevant Health Service Center, if you wish to substitute the results from medical examinations you received at the Health Service Center or another clinic within the last three months instead.
