Response to University of Tokyo's Guidelines for Strengthening Measures to Prevent Coronavirus Infections

On July 20, Dr. Fukuda, executive director and chair of the UTokyo coronavirus task force, issued the attached guidelines for strengthening measures to prevent infections with the novel coronavirus. (An English translation of those guidelines is now being prepared.) In accordance with those guidelines, the Komaba I Campus will implement enhanced measures to prevent the spread of infections.

Entrance to the Komaba I campus is already being monitored by means of the Campus Entry/Facilities Use Application Site. I have consulted with Dr. Fukuda, and he has approved our continued use of that site on that condition that site users are asked to provide additional information and that data obtained through the site is provided to UTokyo's Health Service Center. You will be notified separately about the changes to the information that you need to provide through that site.

We will also inform you later about other details of the Komaba I Campus's strengthened measures for preventing infections in accordance with the University's new guidelines. Your continued understanding and cooperation will be appreciated.
