



Precautions for the New Year Holiday



There are many opportunities to drink alcohol during the New Year Holiday.

Please be careful of the following points in order to prevent incidents/accidents.

【P R O H I B I T I O N S】

- Underage drinking (Under 20 years of age must not drink alcohol).
- Dangerous behavior such as excessive drinking, chug-a-lug drinking (*ikki-nomi* in Japanese), forcing others to drink alcohol (Alcohol Harassment).
- Drink-driving (Drink-cycling is also strictly prohibited).

【Recent Incidents/Accidents】

- Underage drinking at a party.
- Forcing others to drink alcohol (including drinking competition).
- Taken on ambulance because of excessive drinking, and causing trouble to others in public.
- Traffic accident under the influence of alcohol.

In addition to alcohol-related incidents, the University of Tokyo will also take seriously (e.g. disciplinary action) against any other inappropriate behavior (accident or breach of rules) by its students.

Even during the holiday, please always bear in mind that you are “a student of the University of Tokyo,” and act responsibly.
