Notwithstanding the scale as described above in item ①, the following courses may be assessed as pass or fail.

(1) Courses taken at overseas universities in accordance with Article 14-3, 14-516-2 the University of Tokyo General Rules on College /Faculties including"Overseas Learning" among Liberal Arts Courses for Advanced Students

(2) "Special Lectures of Liberal Arts for Advanced Students", "Special Seminars of Liberal Arts for Advanced Students" and "Global Praxis (Advanced)" among Liberal Arts Courses for Advanced Students

(3) Courses of "Internship" and "Praxis in East Asian Liberal Arts" for Cross-disciplinary Program

[Grade Evaluation]

The grade of "A+" will be given to the top 5-10% of students in the class, the grade of "A" is approximately the top 30%, including "A+" students.

There are some courses to which the above rules do not apply, such as graduation theses, graduation research, seminars, laboratory work, practical training, courses for small number of students (less than 20 students), courses for pedagogy program, and special courses for exchange program.

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
