Notes on "Graduation Thesis" Submission

The deadline, date, and time limit for submitting a graduation thesis must be strictly observed (The thesis must be formatted and submitted in accordance with the instructions given by each program.). Late submission will not be accepted in any cases except in special circumstances.

If there were to be any delay in the submission of the formatted and completed thesis due to unpredictable accidents that are not attributed to the student, the thesis might be accepted only as a rare case. In such a case, the student must consult the Program Director immediately and submit the thesis along with the state of the reason for the delay to the Program Director. In the statement, the student must explain the delay specifically and that it was due to unpredictable circumstances caused by nothing attributable to the student. The document of proof is required to be attached to it.

The late acceptance of the thesis with the statement might be subject to discussion by the Senior Division Committee. Please note that such an acceptance applies only to exceptional cases and that reasons such as computer malfunctions or internet connection problems are NOT included (Students shall be responsible for the timely submitting the thesis in principle.).
