Notice

1. Issue of Warning Tickets

On Tuesday 11 June, the University attached yellow warning tickets to bicycles unregistered with the University and left without permission on Komaba campus.

2. Notice Period

The above-mentioned warning tickets carry a grace period of two weeks (until 25 June), during which the bicycle owners are required to confirm their ownership. If you intend to continue to use a bicycle with a warning ticket on campus, please register your bicycle with the relevant department as soon as possible.

3. Retention Period

Bicycles which still have warning tickets after the two-week grace period will be deemed ownerless and classified for disposal. They will be <u>retained for approximately 1 month (until 23 July)</u>.

4. Disposal

Once the retention period is over, the University will dispose of all the bicycles classified for disposal according to prescribed procedure.
