


How to Register for Courses

(on UTAS)

http://www.c.u-tokyo.ac.jp/eng site/zenki/ Courses > Junior Division > Course Registration

- (1) Courses automatically registered (Required Courses: Intensive Japanese III, First-Year Seminar II, Mathematics I②*, Mathematics II②*, Introductory Physics*, Introductory Chemistry*) *only for NS II students
 - Check them on your [Course Registration] screen (available from Apr. 5).
 - You cannot remove required courses.
- (2) Courses you choose and register (Elective Courses)
 - Click "Not registered" time slots or "Register for biweekly classes, etc." or "Register for intensive courses etc." on your [Course Registration] screen to choose and register.



<Registration Period>

For S Semester/S1/S2 Term: Apr. 25 (Tue) 2:00 p.m. – Apr. 27 (Thu) 4:50 p.m.

<Correction Period>

For S Semester/S1/S2 Term: May 2 (Tue) 10:00a.m. – May 10 (Wed) 4:50 p.m.

For S2 Term: May 2 (Tue) 10:00a.m. – May 10 (Wed) 4:50 p.m.

Jun.13(Tue) 10:00a.m. – Jun.16(Fri) 4:50p.m.

- You can change, remove and add courses in this period.
- You cannot correct the courses requiring instructor's approval (See below).

- Courses offered to April-entry students ("PEAK Academic Handbook" p.32)
- "Medical Care Course" of "Physical Education and Health Sciences" ("PEAK Academic Handbook" p.24)

For S Semester/S1 Term: Apr. 5 (Wed) — May 10 (Wed) 4:50 p.m.

For S2 Term: Jun.5 (Mon) — Jun. 16 (Fri) 4:50 p.m.

- Registrations, Corrections and Submissions cannot be made outside of the period.
- You will not be able to take the exam-period exam for the courses which you have not registered, and no grade will be given.
