

Class Delivery Method for S Semester (S1/S2 Term) AY2026

To PEAK Junior Division Students,

For Junior Division courses in S Semester (S1/S2 Term) AY2026, there will be two methods for class delivery.

1. Courses in which the number of students enrolled is confirmed and courses conducted in small groups

For courses listed below, **course instructors will choose whether to conduct classes in person or online/on-demand during the first week of S Semester/S1 Term (April 6 to April 10)**. From the second week onwards, classes will be conducted in person in principle.

- Foundation Courses (excluding “Social Sciences” and “Humanities”)
- “Sports and Fitness Exercises” in Integrated Courses Group D
- Integrated Courses Group L
- Intermediate Courses

2. For all other courses, **classes during the first week (April 6 to April 10) will be held online**.

Please refer to the page on “[Preparing for Online Classes at the University of Tokyo](#)” and prepare electronic devices for online classes on your own accordingly. From the second week onwards, classes will be conducted in person. However, some courses may be offered in person from the first week even if they are not covered by 1. Be sure to check UTAS and UTOL for details.

Separately, **some classes may be held online/on-demand throughout the semester/term**, so please make it a habit to check UTAS and UTOL.
