(1) Courses you choose and register (Elective Courses)

- Check them on your [Course Registration] screen (available from Apr. 5).
- Click "Not registered" time slots or "Register for biweekly classes, etc." or "Register for intensive courses etc." on your [Course Registration] screen to choose and register.

- Registrations, Corrections and Submissions cannot be made outside of the period.
- You will not be able to take the exam-period exam for the courses which you have not registered, and no grade will be given.

For the 2023S Semester, almost all courses will be conducted face-to-face in principle except for the class/es in the first week from April 5 to April 11.
