

How to read the Grade Report for 2S Semester & 2S2 Term

(1) Required Credits /Credits Gained/ Further Credits Required

- **"Required Credits":** Course and credit requirements for completion of the Junior Division, and advancing to the Senior Division. (Please refer to PEAK Academic Handbook P.18.)
- If you do not fulfill the requirements for advancing to the Senior Division at the end of the 2S Semester, you will be automatically required to repeat a year.
- "Credits Gained": The credits you have gained by the end of 2S Semester.
- The credits for courses passed by the overall point average are included.
- If you have gained the credits more than the number of Required Credits, they will be included in "Others" section.
- The gained credits for English I and Intermediate Courses are included in "Others" section.
- "Further Credits Required": The credits required to gain for advancing to the Senior Division.
- These are shown only when you do not have enough credits for the requirements.

(2) Percentage Point Averages for Each Course Group, and Basic Point Average

Percentage Point Averages and the number of credits for courses (whose grade points have been) used in the calculation of Basic Point Average will be recorded on the Grade Report. Please note that the "Basic Point Average" indicated in "Percentage Point Averages" section is a weighted average and based on the credits and grade points received from all courses taken except for Thematic Courses. For details, see the following pages on "Introduction of Basic Point Average".

(3) Courses that Determine Pass/Fail by Overall Point Average

Check your overall point average and Pass/Fail from the "Credits Gained" section for each course category, or grades for each course category on the left side of the Grade Report. For further information, refer to p.62 of the PEAK Academic Handbook.

(4) "Course Term" on the Grade Report

"Course Term" shown on the Grade Report indicates the term when the course was offered. Courses for S1 Term will be "20. $04\sim20.05$ ", courses for S2 Term will be "20.06 ~20.07 ", and courses for S Semester will be shown as "20. $04\sim20.07$ " on the grade report. For Senior Division Courses, the grades will appear on UTAS after you have advanced to the Senior Division.
