Dear all students,

Due to a combination of Prof. Cohen’s reputation and the timeliness of the topics he will teach, coupled with the need to manage group work in the afternoon sessions, it is necessary for us to restrict the number of students attending the course, “Human Population Dynamics” (by Prof. J. E. Cohen) as follows. All students must pre-register to attend the course. To do so, please e-mail Prof. Shimada.

[1] Students who won’t undertake the group work in the afternoon sessions will not be approved to get course credit (2 units).

午後のグループワークに参加しない学生には単位(2 単位)は認めない。

[2] Students who do not require course credit may attend just the lectures in the morning sessions on the condition that the total number of students attending is less than the auditorium capacity of 120 seats.

単位を希望せずに午前中の講義だけ受講したい場合は、学際交流ホールの収容数 120 名に達しない限り、参加を認める。

[3] Students who wish to obtain course credit will be prioritized for enrolment onto the course as follows:

単位を希望する学生は、以下の優先順位でその学生に受講を認める。

(1) Students of PEAK/GPEAK (GSP+GPES), Department of Interdisciplinary Sciences, Department of Multi-Disciplinary Sciences

PEAK/GPEAK(GSP + GPES) 及び 学際科学科、広域科学専攻の学生

(2) Students of other departments of the Graduate School of Arts and Sciences

総合文化研究科内の(1)以外の専攻の学生

(3) Students from other departments and graduate schools in Hongo and Kashiwa. In general, a maximum of 15 such students will be accepted, based on the order of applications, unless the total number of students (1)+(2) is less than 30, in which case additional students may attend up to a grand total of 45 students.

その他の本郷と柏の研究科の学生で、最多で 15 名まで (問い合わせ順で)。

ただし、(1)と(2)の合計が 30 名に達しない時には、総計で 45 名まで(3)の学生の受講を受け付ける。
