Tim received his BSc in Molecular and Cellular Biology from the University of Bath, UK, and a PhD in Developmental Biology from University College London, where he studied the role of tolloid-related metalloproteases in embryonic patterning. Tim moved to the National Institute for Medical Research in London, establishing genetic mapping tools for *Xenopus tropicalis* with a specific interest in mutations affecting sarcomere formation, before returning to University College London to help to build an interactive atlas of the zebrafish brain. After briefly working in the biotech sector, Tim joined Nature Reviews in February 2013 as a cross-title Associate Editor supporting all eight clinical titles. From April 2014, Tim spent 10 months as a locum Associate Editor for *Nature Reviews Cardiology*. He joined the *Nature Reviews Endocrinology* team as a Senior Editor in May 2015.
