# Guidelines for Applications for Resident Assistant (RA) for PEAK Students

# 1. Number of Positions

Up to 5 male and 5 female students

# 2. Responsibilities

To provide guidance and support to PEAK students as Resident Assistant (RA) living in the International Lodge Komaba Lodge B, C, or D for one academic year beginning in September 2015.

<Job description>

1. Be available at the time of emergency and make appropriate contact with PEAK students and lodge administrators as well as other administrators and professors, if necessary.

2. Support PEAK students at the time of check-in to the lodge.

3. Provide daily support to PEAK students. (For example, showing them the locations of supermarkets and other shops and explaining lodge facilities such as the kitchen, lounge, and shower.)

4. Inform PEAK students of events sponsored by Komaba International Office and Globalization Office.

5. Observe the rules made by Komaba Lodge.

6. Provide other necessary support for PEAK students so that they may adjust smoothly to life at the lodge.

## 4. Eligibility

All of the following conditions 1) - 4) must be satisfied:

1) Applicants must be enrolled in a regular course of either the Senior Division of the College of Arts and Sciences or any Graduate School of the University of Tokyo, as of September 1, 2015.

2) Applicants must be willing to build a good relationship with PEAK students living in Komaba Lodge.

3) Applicants must have a good command of English and Japanese.

4) Applicants must be able to start living in the Lodge on Monday, August 31, 2015.

## 8. Selection Process

Candidates will be selected by screening based on submitted documents, followed by an interview, which will be held within 3 weeks of the deadline for submission of application documents. Applicants must be available for an interview held at Komaba Campus on site, or by Skype if they are unable to attend in person for unavoidable reasons. Details of the interview and the results will be announced by e-mail.
